How To Buy Your Books

FFC maintains a virtual bookstore through MBS Direct.

Through MBS Direct you can order new books, purchase used books (if they are available), and resell your books to the company through their guaranteed buy-back program. The warehouse is in Missouri, and our students in Oklahoma usually receive their books within 3 days.

Our staff works very closely with MBS to have the textbooks for each scheduled class available on the website and ready to order. But, we do make mistakes. Our goal is to make your ordering process as easy as possible, so please let us know if you are having difficulty.

If your particular course is not listed on FFC's Virtual Bookstore, then you are probably taking that course outside of our regularly scheduled courses. Because the majority of these situations will be online courses, you should check the Atheneo system to find out which books are required for the course. You can purchase them through the general textbook site offered by MBS Direct: www.textbooks.com or you can use the Atheneo system's link to purchase textbooks through their virtual bookstore from www.ecampus.com.

If you would like to purchase books utilizing financial aid funds, you must complete a book voucher to be submitted to the financial aid office. You can obtain this form from Rhonda, who will also answer any questions you have regarding it: rgaines@familyoffaithcollege.edu; 405.273.5331 ext. 302.
